RANDWICK COUNCIL UPDATE

We are working very closely with Randwick Council to ensure that our courts are first class and a beautiful place for us to spend our Saturdays.

The Council have been working on Heffron Park, installing a safety fence behind Courts 1-6 as well as planted new gardens throughout the Car park area.

The Toilet Block near Court 20 will be cleaned and improved to allow better access to the storage area for clubs with the installation of a roller door.

The Courts from 7-20 have also been extended at each end to ensure that the runoff is safe for our umpires and players. The building will have a new sign "HEFFRON PARK NETBALL CENTRE" installed on the Fitzgerald Avenue side.
