OUR NEW AMENITIES BLOCK IS OPEN

On Saturday we officially opened our new amenities block at Heffron Park — and it has given our community another first-class facility to use.

The building sits right in the middle of our courts, which means it is accessible to everyone, no matter which court you are on. It includes a club house store with ramp access so every club can store their club tents, and it has freed up much needed room in our container for goal post pads and training equipment.

The facility was delivered by Randwick City Council in partnership with the NSW Government, and includes:

- A large change room
- Female dedicated bathrooms
- An accessible (DDA) bathroom
- 5 x unisex bathrooms
- An umpires bathroom

- A sports groups storeroom, including our club house store with ramp access
